

CEAS Chinese for Business Course Development Fellowship
Summer 2019

The Title VI grant provides funding (\$3,000) in summer salary for the development of a 3 credit hour language class that will fit into their schedule. This class is meant to make it easier for professional school students, who have difficulty adding the regular 5 credit (everyday class), to fit first year Chinese into their schedules. This is not a Chinese business class, but a regular and more practical Chinese usage class. These professional school students are unlikely to double major in Chinese, but they are looking for a practical Chinese language course that can fit into their schedule. The new course is EALC 300 level or above so this course can also count towards the minor.

Please provide a two page proposal with the following:

- 1.) A syllabus outline for the semester long course. This is only one page and can be a general outline detailing course goals and the material covered over the semester. You can also discuss how this course differs from the 5 credit hour course.
- 2.) Include a time line for the new course. The syllabus and course material must be completed by August 2019. The new course must be submitted in Fall 2019 and the course needs to be available to teach in Fall 2020 or Spring 2021.
