

CEAS New Non-language Course Development Grants (3)
Summer 2019

The Title VI grant provides funding (\$2,500 x3) in summer salary for the development of new non-language courses focusing on Uyghur and Tibetan speaking regions in order to strengthen the number and quality of courses that support these languages. These new classes are meant to enhance the language courses and provide undergraduate students with a broader cultural and social understanding of Uyghur and Tibetan societies. The new courses are 3 credit hour courses EALC 300 level or above so these course can also count towards the major and minor.

Please provide a two page proposal with the following:

- 1.) A syllabus outline for the semester long course. This is only one page and can be a general outline detailing course goals and the material covered over the semester. You can also discuss how this course fits with the current Uyghur and Tibetan language classes.
- 2.) Include a timeline for the new course. The syllabus and course material must be completed by August 2019. The new course must be submitted in Fall 2019 and the course needs to be available to teach in Fall 2020 or Spring 2021.
