

CEAS Open Access Instructional Material Fellowships for Chinese and Korean
Summer 2019

The Title VI grant provides funding (\$2,500 x2) in summer salary for the development of new language learning modules for Korean and Chinese to serve students of these languages at KU and elsewhere. These online open access materials are to be designed as ten language modules that will be available through KU Open Educational Resources (OER) at <http://oer.ku.edu>. Each module is a stand along lesson and designed to assist first and/or second year language students. These can be listening and reading exercises with comprehension question or simpler flash cards (see quizlet.com). Each module will be written up in a Word document and then uploaded to OER with the help of Jon Perkins at EGARC. Examples of these language modules can be found at <http://oer.ku.edu> under “Italian” and “Russian”.

Please provide a two page proposal with the following:
